Request for Scholarship



Policy

Mid-Cities Basketball Association, Inc. (MCBBA) seeks to make its programs available to all eligible youth, regardless of their financial resources. At the same time, MCBBA is committed to sound financial policy to ensure the ongoing success of our league.

Therefore, it is the policy of the MCBBA to use net proceeds from concessions sales, contributions from individuals, sponsors, and special events (such as coaches exhibition games) to underwrite requests for "scholarships" to assist players to participate in basketball. The scholarship program must be self-sustaining; no portion of any "full fee" registration may be used to fund "scholarships."

MCBBA does not represent that all qualifying applicants will receive a "scholarship." Only a limited number of "scholarships" are available each season, and they are awarded on a first-come first served basis.

In order to qualify for a "scholarship", applicants must present their "free" or "reduced price" meal letter from their school district. No other documentation is acceptable. The letter may only be presented at inperson registration event. Consequently for 2018-19 season, the last date to apply for scholarship is November 3, 2018 assuming scholarships are still available.

For individual registration, HEB ISD applicants who qualify for a "scholarship" will pay **\$50.00**. Non-HEB ISD applicants who otherwise qualify, and present similar documentation, will pay **\$70.00**, the difference being the subsidized gym rental fee provided by HEB ISD for their son archip students.
